

MAX Is Affecting Positive Change for LGBTQ People in the Ukraine — And You Can Help, Too!

Several weeks ago, I had the good fortune to meet a young Ukrainian videographer — Yuriy Drizhov — who interviewed me regarding MAX for a documentary he is doing for Ukrainian TV.

The documentary will be focusing — in part — on what the US can teach the Ukraine about accepting LGBTQ people. He believes MAX is a terrific model for Ukrainian gay men who — when over 40 and single — often tend to socially isolate themselves. *This is a cultural norm*. He asked me to explain what MAX has done, starting at a time when gay men were isolating themselves during the AIDS crisis through today where we have evolved to a thriving social community. *He believes we can be role models that will empower our counterparts in the Ukraine to do something similar so they can enjoy better lives*.

It's humbling to think that, through this film, MAX's reach will be going far, far beyond SF.

But you can help even further. Yuri is doing a fundraiser on GoFundMe to help complete the documentary. I've already contributed and promoted it on Facebook... and the head of video software at Apple immediately offered to help him. I'd like to personally ask each of you – the MAX members – if you can also contribute to this cause. The link is below.

It is our common experience that could help affect positive change for gay men in the Ukraine. <u>So please give what you can.</u>
